Municipal elections 2021 - From volunteerism to municipal politics

The next municipal elections are fast approaching! On November 7th, more than 8,000 positions will be up for election in Quebec. In the last municipal elections of 2017, 56.3% of the positions (councillor, mayor) were filled without opposition. Yet, citizen participation is essential to ensure the health of municipal democratic life!

The ministère des Affaires municipales et de l'Habitation (MAMH) would like to invite everyone who is already involved in their community to consider the possibility of taking the leap into municipal politics. Municipal volunteers, in particular, often have qualities and skills that are very important to elected officials, such as knowledge of local issues, the ability to listen and a desire to work for the community.

If you want to put your skills to even greater use in your municipality, represent the interests of the public and participate in the decision-making process, you probably have what it takes to apply.

Think about it! Municipalities are truly local governments. They offer a very attractive environment for people who want to get involved. Don't hesitate to find out more on the subject.
