		The tree must be felled for the siting of buildings, structures or works authorized in the zoning by-law;
		The tree is located within a 5-metre band around an existing main building or within a 2-metre band around an existing accessory building or structure (the band is calculated horizontally from the walls of the building or its foundation);
		The tree is dead or in an irreversible state of decay;
		The tree must be removed because of the risk that it will spread a disease or an exotic invasive species;
		The tree must be removed because of an irreversible condition caused by disease, a structural deficiency affecting its strength, or serious damage to property. Normal inconveniences associated with the presence of a tree, such as falling twigs, leaves, flowers, or fruit, the presence of roots on the surface of the ground, the presence of insects or animals, shade, bad odors, exudation of sap or honeydew, or the release of pollen, shall not constitute serious damage;

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- An application for a certificate of authorization must be submitted to the municipality in two paper copies and one electronic copy (PDF); The applicant must complete and sign the certificate of authorization application form and submit all required documents to provide a complete application. **GENERAL CONTENT** The application for a certificate of authorization must contain the following plans and documents (the designated officer may advise the applicant that certain plans and documents are not required considering the nature of the work and the information necessary to establish the conformity of the intervention with the urbanism by-laws); Felling of a tree: \Box (1) A plan showing the location of the tree or trees to be felled: ☐ (2) Photographs showing the tree or trees to be felled; (3) The reasons why the tree or trees are to be felled and any supporting documentation deemed necessary by the designated official. \rightarrow In addition, the trees involved shall be identified by tape or any other appropriate means prior to filing the application. Tree felling in a damaged stand: ☐ A forest and wildlife management plan, jointly signed by a forest engineer and a biologist, which provides justification for the need for the cut and includes at a minimum: a) The identification of the area's landowner;
 - b) A description of the property ownership:
 - c) A description of the owner's objectives for the area:
 - d) A description of the wildlife habitats and their features:
 - An explanation of the enhancement work to be carried out over the next 10 years;
 - Infrastructure planning;
