SUBJECT : ENVIRONMENT DAY (SATURDAY, JUNE 17) AND INFORMATION SESSIONS (PROTECTED AREA PROJECT)

Dear citizens,

As our municipality is very focused on the protection of the environment and biodiversity, we are pleased to announce that we will be holding an Environment Day on Saturday, June 17, from 10 AM to 2 PM, at the PLTN marina (454 Chemin de Lac Tremblant Nord).

During this day, which will take place outside on the shores of Lake Tremblant :

- Various organizations (SNAP Québec, Éco-corridors laurentiens, SÉPAQ, Sûreté du Québec (SQ), Ville de Mont-Tremblant Fire Department, etc.) will have information booths on site to discuss with our citizens good environmental practices to adopt, and the importance of protecting biodiversity;
- Activities are also planned for children (including a visit of the Ville de Mont-Tremblant's fire truck);
- Prizes for children and adults will be drawn among participants; and
- A FREE BBQ will be served for the occasion.

More details regarding the Environment Day will be communicated to everyone in the coming weeks.

Information sessions (questions and answers) - Lac-Tremblant-Nord Protected Area project

As the municipality wishes to continue its efforts to protect the environment and biodiversity, Lac-Tremblant-Nord has initiated, jointly with *Les Amis de Lac-Tremblant-Nord* and the *Canadian Parks and Wilderness Society (SNAP Québec)*, a project aimed at creating a protected area and reinforcing an ecological corridor on the municipality's public territory.

Benefiting from strategic guidance and financial support from SNAP Québec, this project's mission is to ensure the protection of biodiversity, the preservation of the integrity of ecosystems (including water quality of lakes, rivers and fish habitats) and the maintenance of the integrity of the landscape of Lac-Tremblant-Nord.

In order to present the project to the citizens of Lac-Tremblant-Nord and to answer questions regarding the project, two information sessions are planned:

- Tuesday, June 6 at 6 PM Online via Webex
- Saturday, June 17 from 10 to 11:30 AM In person at the PLTN marina (before the start of the Environment Day activities beginning at 11:30 AM).

During these information sessions, a PowerPoint presentation of the project will be presented, and citizens will be able to interact with our various partners, experts in biodiversity protection, who are accompanying us in the project.

Instructions on how to connect to the first information session on June 6 will be communicated to everyone in the coming weeks.
