



TOTAL BAN ON OPEN-AIR FIRES IN LAC-TREMBLANT-NORD

As of May 29, 2023, <u>A BAN ON OPEN-AIR FIRES IN OR NEAR FORESTS IN ALL REGIONS OF QUEBEC</u> has been announced by the Ministère des Ressources naturelles et des Forêts (MRNF) and the SOPFEU.

As the fire danger index is currently at the « EXTREME » level for the Laurentians region and given the weather conditions forecast for the coming week, <u>A BAN ON ALL OUTDOOR FIRES WILL BE IN EFFECT IN LAC-TREMBLANT-NORD UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.</u>

THE BAN APPLIES TO ALL TYPES OF FIREPLACES, INCLUDING OUTDOOR FIREPLACES EQUIPPED WITH SPARK SCREENS, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF NATURAL GAS OR PROPANE FIREPLACES.

As soon as the fire danger index permits it, the ban on open fires will be lifted.

Everyone's cooperation is essential if the ban on open fires is to be respected, as this measure is designed to limit the risk of forest fires.
