 - Prizes for children and adults will be drawn among participants;
 - A FREE BBQ will be served for the occasion (Hotdogs, hamburgers and vegetarian options).

At the event, if you are a PLTN member, you can use the marina's parking lot. Otherwise, in order not to overcrowd the marina's parking lot on this busy weekend, we would ask that you please park your car along chemin de Lac-Tremblant-Nord.

We will provide limited seating at the event, but for citizens who wish to sit outside, we would encourage you to bring a folding or camping chair if you have one.
