## Open-air fires: Partial lifting of the ban

(Lac-Tremblant-Nord, June 30, 2023) - Considering the <u>partial</u> lifting of the ban on open-air fires in parts of Quebec as proposed by <u>SOPFEU</u>, and following the evolution of weather conditions in several regions, the measure is modified as of today, in order to allow open-air fires.

However, in view of the poor air quality caused by smoke from the fires that continue to rage in Quebec, and given that the smoke, composed of several gases and fine particles, affects many people, it is recommended that open fires only be set when **strictly necessary**, as the risks to health and the environment are very real.
